



## Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority.

Cage & Associates, Ltd/Safe-Screen is a licensed private investigative, security and Consumer Reporting Agency (CRA) that generates Consumer Reports and/or Investigative Consumer Reports for legitimate organizations with a valid permissible purpose on consumers (applicants) who have provided appropriate Authorization and Disclosure as outlined in the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA). All data is maintained on secure servers on a separate site and accessible only to authorized users for legitimate needs. A consumer may have the right to inspect any data about them and to object to any data pursuant to the FCRA and to request a copy of their data according to the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions (FACT) Act.

All consumer (applicant) processing is conducted in the United States. Personally Identifiable Information (PII) is maintained and transmitted via secure methods and does not leave the US. If Safe-Screen is requested to perform a international verification, only that information that is absolutely needed by the verification institution or international researcher is released. ### Collection of your Personal Information

Safe-Screen may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Safe-Screen. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Safe-Screen website.

#### Use of your Personal Information

Safe-Screen collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Safe-Screen may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Safe-Screen and its affiliates. Safe-Screen may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Safe-Screen does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Safe-Screen may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Safe-Screen, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Safe-Screen may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Safe-Screen, in order to determine what Safe-Screen services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Safe-Screen to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

#### Use of Cookies

Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page.
